

Counting Beans

One bushel of soybeans weighs 60 pounds.

1. How much would ½ bushel weigh? $60 \div 2 = \underline{\quad}$
2. How much would 3 bushels weigh? $60 \times 3 = \underline{\quad}$

Soybeans need to be planted 2 inches apart.

3. How many seeds can you plant in a row that is 100 inches long? $100 \div 2 = \underline{\quad}$
4. What about in a row that is 50 inches long? $50 \div 2 = \underline{\quad}$
5. Add the two previous rows together, how many total seeds can you plant? $50 + 25 = \underline{\quad}$
